

## Virtual Open Water Development Days 2021 Code of Conduct for Athletes

## As a selected athlete we expect you to:

## **Essentials**

- 1. Keep yourself safe by listening to the Regional coaches and support staff, behave responsibly and speak out when something isn't right.
- 2. Be ready to log in on time and if you're running late, let a member of the team know.
- 3. Make your coach or team organiser aware if you have any difficulties during the day.
- 4. Be prepared with the correct kit in a suitable areas.
- 5. Respect the privacy of others, especially around the use of phones and social media during the day.

## **Behaviour**

- 1. Make our development day activity a fun, happy, friendly and welcoming place to be.
- 2. Respect and celebrate difference in our Regions and not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of age, gender, race, sexual orientation, faith or ability.
- 3. Understand that the use of abusive or inappropriate language, bullying, or any other behaviour which hurts others will not be tolerated by the Region.
- 4. Not use any device to take photographs or footage during the day.
- 5. Report any concerns you have about others taking photographs or footage during the day.
- 6. Understand that poor behaviour may result in the Region taking disciplinary action against you. Any behaviour which may be a criminal offence will be reported to police by the club.
- 7. Report any incidents of bullying or unkind behaviour to the regional team, even if you're just a witness.
- 8. Treat other athletes with respect and appreciate that everyone has a different strengths.
- 9. Support and encourage athletes regardless of their base club.
- 10. Respect all Coaches and Supporting members throughout the day.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action being taken against you by the Region.
